

## **Melchizedek & Jesus (Hebrews 7)**

**Genesis 14:18.** Then **Melchizedek** king of Salem brought out bread and wine. He was priest of God Most High, , **19** and he blessed Abram, saying, “Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth. **20** And praise be to God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand.” Then Abram gave him a tenth of everything.

**Psalms 110:4.** The Lord has sworn and will not change his mind: “You are a priest forever, in the order of **Melchizedek.**”

**Hebrews 5:6.** And he says in another place, “You are a priest forever, in the order of **Melchizedek.**”

**Hebrews 5:10.** and was designated by God to be high priest in the order of **Melchizedek.**

**Hebrews 6:20.** where our forerunner, Jesus, has entered on our behalf. He has become a high priest forever, in the order of **Melchizedek.**

**Hebrews 7:1-2.** This **Melchizedek** was king of Salem and priest of God Most High. He met Abraham returning from the defeat of the kings and blessed him, and Abraham gave him a tenth of everything. First, the name **Melchizedek** means “king of righteousness”; then also, “king of Salem” means “king of peace.”

**Hebrews 7:10-11.** because when **Melchizedek** met Abraham, Levi was still in the body of his ancestor. **11** If perfection could have been attained through the Levitical priesthood—and indeed the law given to the people established that priesthood—why was there still need for another priest to come, one in the order of **Melchizedek**, not in the order of Aaron?

**Hebrews 7:15.** And what we have said is even more clear if another priest like **Melchizedek** appears.

**Hebrews 7:17.** For it is declared: “You are a priest forever, in the order of **Melchizedek.**”
