How do I use this reading plan?

This plan is designed to be used by individuals and groups.

Personal Study:

- Read the five chapters 1-3 times during the week - one per day or multiple each day
- Memorize the Scripture passage for the week
- Write or draw out thoughts. Below are some inductive methods for study:
 - Observe, Interpret, Apply - What does it say? What does it mean? How should we respond?
 - Highlight, Explain, Apply, Respond
 - Seven Arrows - www.sevenarrowsbible.com

Groups:

- Core (3-5) - Study on your own and come together to share your journal thoughts, recite scripture together, hold one another accountable for the application of God's word, and pray together
- Community (10-20) - Have a lesson and discussion based on the weekly reading or memory verse

For kids:

- Read with your kids or have them read a portion of the scripture readings for the week
- Have kids write thoughts or draw a picture related to the reading
- Discuss at bedtime or over dinner
- Pray together

What if I want to read more of the Bible?

Supplement your reading with other Scripture

- Gospel plans, study the passage with the memory verse, or read according to interest or need
